Tennis and Basketball Court Rules

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS

1. Residents who are currently members of the Compton Village Homeowners Association
2. Non-resident guests playing with Association Members who must be in attendance during play
3. Association approved instructors

TENNIS and BASKETBALL COURT RULES

1. The courts are to be locked at all times. Keys may be obtained from the Homeowners Association office. There is a \$5.00 deposit charged for each key.
2. The courts are open for play daily from 7:00 AM to dusk.
3. Play is defined as having a game or two or more players practicing on the same court.
4. Use of the courts is on a first-come first-serve basis.
5. All players (except guests) should be prepared to identify themselves as an Association Member.
6. Proper tennis or basketball shoes are required (no cleats or black soled shoes or any soles that will leave marks or destroy the court surface).
7. Tennis singles play is limited to one hour and doubles play is limited to two hours when eligible players are waiting to play.
8. **ALL COURT CHANGES ARE MADE EVERY HOUR, ON THE HOUR.**
9. Players who have used a court for a fraction of an hour must quit on the hour when eligible players are waiting to play.
10. An individual member may not use a court when two eligible players are waiting to play.
11. Those not playing tennis or basketball are not allowed on the courts.
12. Bicycles, skates, skateboards, roller blades, scooters, baby carriages, playpens and pets are not allowed on the courts.
13. No food, alcoholic beverages or radio playing is permitted.

PRIORITY OF PLAY

1. Advance notice will be posted if the Association reserves the courts in order to provide professional lessons to residents.
2. Adults have priority on weekdays after 5:00 PM and on weekends and holidays from 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM.
3. Adults retain priority when playing with a Junior Member (16 years old or younger).
4. Once their play is in progress, junior members may not be asked to leave a court until the usual court change on the hour.
